Application as SPECIALIST / NON-SPECIALIST (delete as appropriate)

BREED SPECIALISTS. A person whose main breed is Cocker Spaniels & who is actively breeding and/or showing.

(a). A minimum of 7 years Judging experience in the Breed at the time of approval & have the support of The Cocker Spaniel Breed Council. **(K.C. Policy).**

(b). Judged THREE Breed Club Shows (Open or Limited Shows; one of which may be Breed Classes at a Championship Show where C.C.s were not on offer, judging a minimum of 12 classes).

**** For BREEDERS RESIDENT IN NORTHERN IRELAND**** this may be Two Breed Club Shows under Kennel Club Regulations & One Green Star under Irish Kennel Club Rules.

(c). Judged a further 60 Classes of Cocker Spaniels at Open or Limited or Championship Shows without C.C.s. with an adequate geographical spread.

(d). Judged a minimum of 350 Cocker Spaniels. **(K.C. Policy).**

(e). To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer & passed the relevant examination on Requirements of a Dog Show Judge. (Also known as Rules & Regulations). (Exam). (Proof to be provided). **(K.C. Policy - 1/7/01).**

f). To have attended a Seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation & Movement - (Part 1) Assessment conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer & passed the assessment. (Proof to be provided). **(K.C. Policy - 1/7/05).**

(g). To have attended a Seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation & Movement - "Hands On" (Part 2) Assessment conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer & passed the assessment -also know as 50 Points of the Dog. (Proof to be provided). **(K.C. Policy - 1/7/05).**

(h). To have attended at least one Cocker Spaniel Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice & passed an examination &/or assessment where applicable. The candidate to have a pass certificate, which didn't start until 2000. (Exam) (Previous years do not comply). (Proof to be provided). **(K.C. Policy - 1/7/05).**

(i) To have attended the appropriate field/working trial as required by Kennel Club Regulations

(j). To have bred &/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book. (save in exceptional circumstances). **(K.C. Policy).**

(k). To have stewarded at 12 Shows held under Kennel Club Regulations. (Proof to be provided). **(K.C. Policy).**

NON BREED SPECIALISTS.

(a). A minimum of 7 years Judging experience in any one Breed (to include 5 years judging Cocker Spaniels) & have the support of The Cocker Spaniel Breed Council. **(K.C. Policy).**

(b). To have judged at TWO Breed Club Shows, one of which may be BREED classes at a Championship Show where CCs were not on offer, judging a minimum of 12 classes.

(c). To have judged a further 60 Classes of Cocker Spaniels at Open or Limited or Championship Shows without C.C.s. with an adequate geographical spread.

(d). To have judged a minimum of 350 Cocker Spaniels. **(K.C. Policy).**

(e). To have awarded CC's. in at least ONE other Breed. **(K.C. Policy).**

(f). To have attended at least one Cocker Spaniel Breed Specific Judging Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice & passed an examination &/or assessment where applicable. (Proof to be provided). **(K.C. Policy - 1/7/05).**

NAMES FOR CONSIDERATION MAY ONLY BE SUBMITTED BY A MEMBER CLUB FOR WHICH THE APPLICANT HAS JUDGED

The number of dogs ACTUALLY JUDGED (showing absentees) shall be declared.
