- (c). To have judged a minimum of 120 Cocker Spaniels.
- (d). To have attended at least one Cocker Spaniel Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice & passed an examination &/or assessment where applicable. The candidate to have a pass certificate, which didn't start until 2000. (Exam) (Previous years do not comply). (Proof to be provided). **(K.C. Policy)**.
- (e). To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer & passed the relevant examination on Requirements of a Dog Show Judge. (Exam). (Also known as Rules & Regulations). (Exam). (Proof to be provided). **(K.C. Policy)**.
- (f) To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation & Movement. (Video. Proof to be provided) **(K.C. Policy)**.

To have attended at least one Cocker Spaniel Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice & passed an examination &/or assessment where applicable. The candidate to have a pass certificate, which didn't start until 2000. (Exam) (Previous years do not comply). (Proof to be provided). **(K.C. Policy)**.
